Safety Tips

- 1. No horseplay of any type.
- 2. No alcoholic beverages or illegal drugs will be allowed.
- 3. Participants should wear gloves, a good quality shoe (no open-toed shoes) and light or bright-colored protective clothing. No clothing should be worn that hinders the visibility of the participant(s).
- 4. For very hot weather, an adequate water supply should be available.
- 5. A good pair of sunglasses, cap and sunblock should be considered.
- 6. Avoid suspected toxic/hazardous substances, poison ivy, poison oak, noxious weeds; areas where herbicides were applied recently, and places were snakes, alligators, wasps, fire ants or other insects may be located.
- 7. Be careful when picking up broken glass, cut aluminum cans or barbed wire.
- 8. Do not attempt to lift heavy objects. Report the description and location to the City Administrator at (386) 228-2358, and ask for a pick up. Call the same number for the removal of dead animals they will notify proper department.
- 9. Work should be done at times avoiding the heat of the day, but when there is good visibility.

IN CASE OF EMERGENCY

- 1. Know the route to the nearest emergency center or the hospital in case of serious injury.
- 2. Have transportation readily available.
- 3. Call 9-1-1 if necessary
